Programs That Are Duplicative of Housing Supports Program (HSP) Services

Several other state programs provide some of the same services offered in the HSP. If a Medicaid member is enrolled in one of these programs, they are ineligible for one or possibly more of the HSP services. These programs are assigned Special Program Codes (SPC) in eMEVS, so providers can use eMEVS to identify if a client is enrolled in a program that makes them ineligible their HSP service(s).
