- While we won't cover everything today, additional HSP resources will be developed to summarize differences/similarities and to curate the key information that providers will use on a regular basis
 - Eg: contact info, important links, templates

- Expect that continuous improvement, workflow refinement and new efficiencies will emerge as the program unfolds

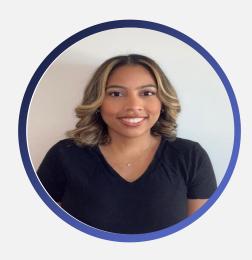

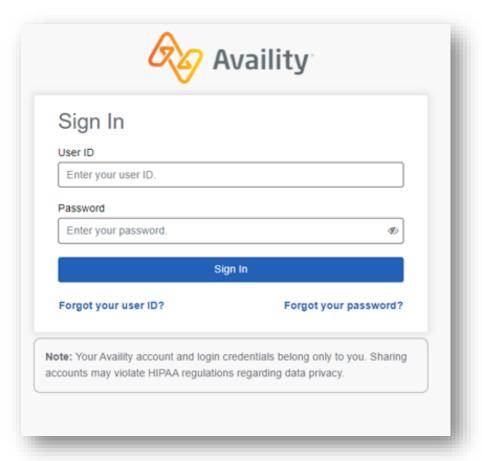

Demonstration of MCO portal and authorization forms: Portal Login Steps

Here the user will enter their credentials to login. Availity is a HIPPA compliant and secure multi-payer portal used by providers, with a single sign on. Meaning providers only have to log on once to access the portal for all payers contracted.

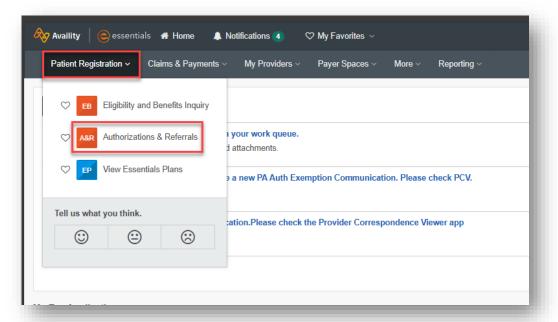




Demonstration of MCO portal and authorization forms: Where to submit authorization forms on portal

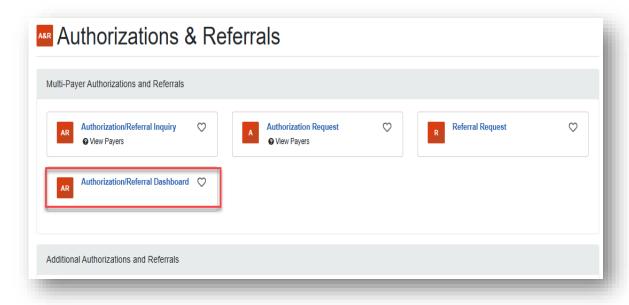

If not submitted in Availity then they will need to perform an inquiry.

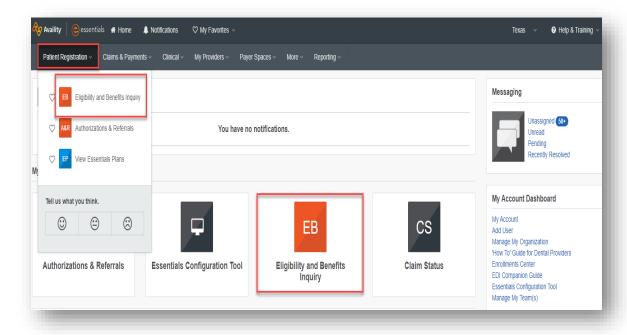

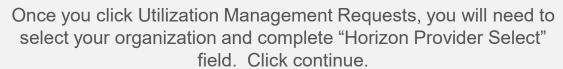


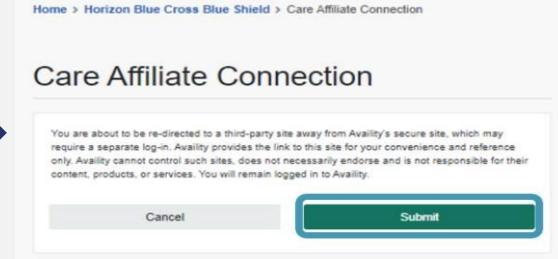
Once logged into Availity, click Payer Spaces dropdown and select plan type for member you are requesting services for.

Scroll within Applications tab to Utilization Management Requests and click.

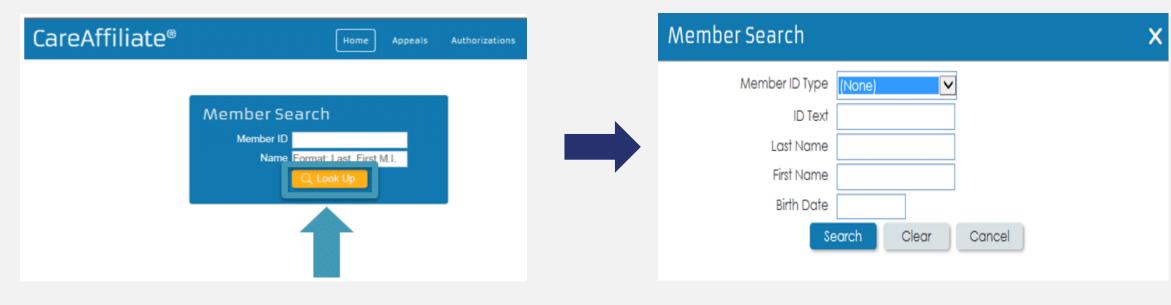






This screen advises that you that you will be re-directed to a platform called CareAffiliate. Click Submit to proceed.

Within CareAffiliate, from the Home tab, click the yellow Look Up button.

You will then see this screen. You can search by Member Name or Member ID.

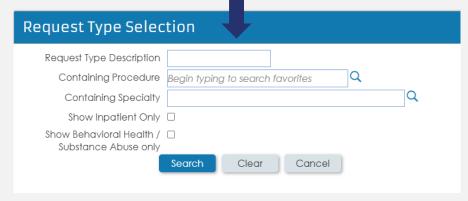

Once member has been found, an authorization can be initiated. Click the New button next to Authorizations option. *Note, if you click the Authorizations link, it will bring up prior submitted requests for selected member.



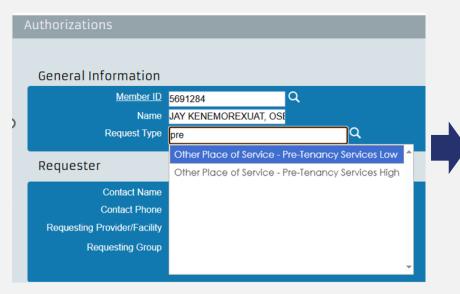

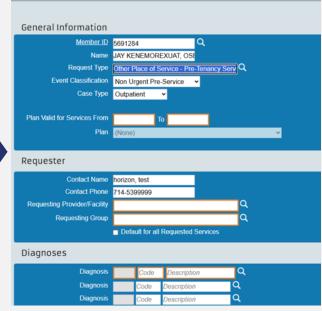
This step allows for entering request type selection. Click magnifying glass next to Request Type. A search box will populate. Then scroll through the list of options and select an option.



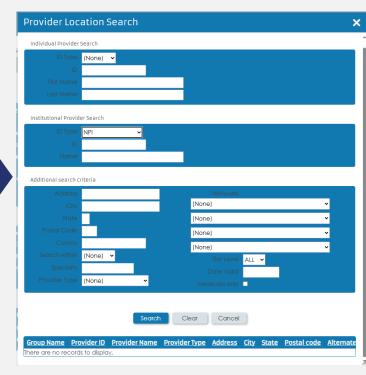

Next, type in Pre-tenancy in the "Request Type" and options for "Pre-tenancy Services Low" and "Pre-tenancy Services High" will come up. Choose Pre-tenancy Services Low or High.

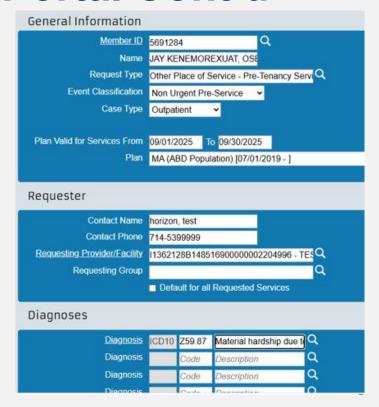


Next, enter 30-day date span under Plan Valid for Services From and To, which will prompt a benefit/eligibility check. Then, click on magnifying glass next to Requesting Provider/Facility or Requesting Group.

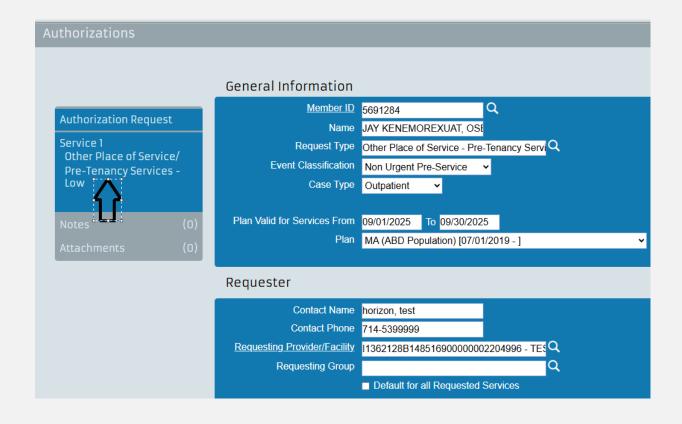


Search box will open. Fill in ID type and ID information and hit Search. Choose the correct option through the search results.

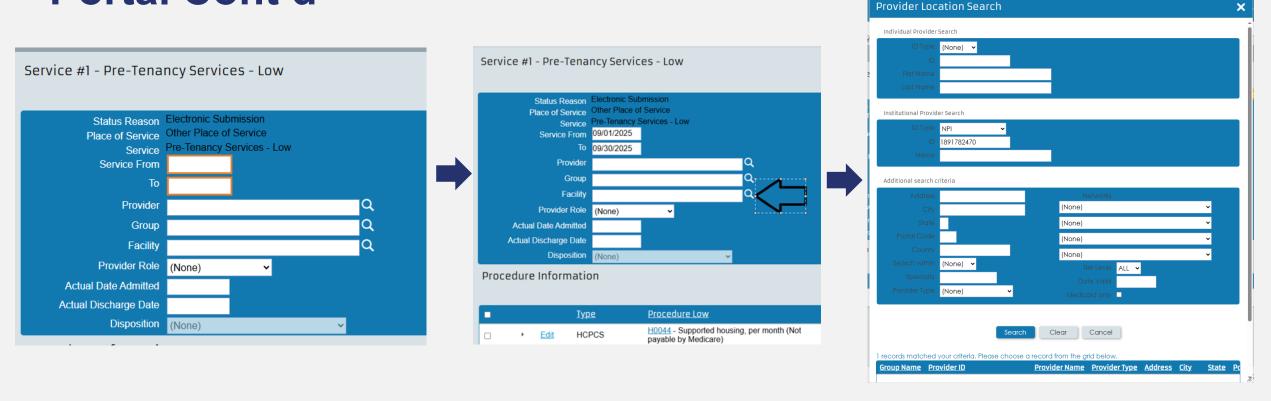
Diagnosis codes can now be added. Click magnifying glass next to description, and search by ICD10/Dx code. Up to 4 diagnoses can be entered in this section.



To initiate adding a service, click Service 1 in the Authorization Request box in upper left side of page.

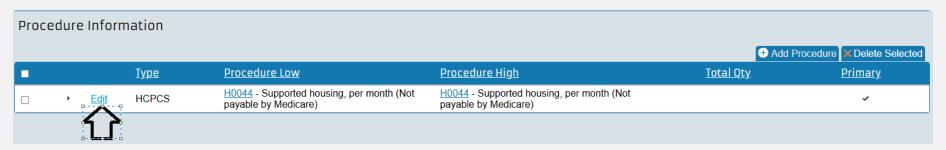

Horizon NJ Health | Submitting HSP PAs via Horizon



When entering dates of service, they must fall within 30-day date span that was initially entered. Click Magnifying glass for Provider, Group or Facility, and repeat provider search steps previously described by searching individual or institutional provider. This time, you must enter rendering provider's information.

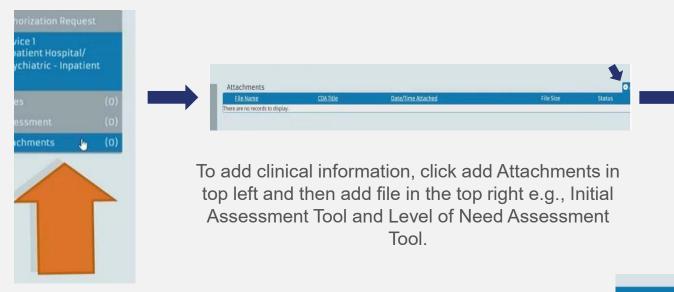


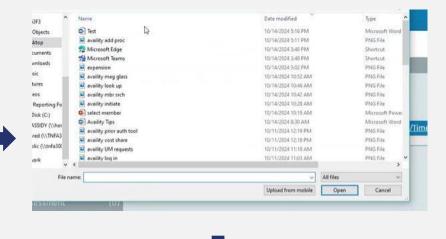
Since a requesting profile was picked, the Procedure information is automatically populated with the Procedure code for Pre-Tenancy Low. Click Edit to enter the units and duration of the service authorization.

Horizon NJ Health | Common provider errors leading to delays in processing

Applicable services	Error	How to avoid
	Not providing correct identifiers	Ensure Documentation has accurate identifying information such as Member ID number, Member name, DOB, and Social Security number
Pre-Tenancy	Unable to reach facility contact due to a generic contact number and/or no confidential voicemail	Provide direct contact and/or a number with a confidential voicemail
 Tenancy Sustaining 	to leave messages	Provide accurate contact information
 Move In Supports 	Not calling back if we are requesting additional information	Call back to discuss additional information request
Residential Modification and Remediation		 Provide exit from program information to Horizon when member is discharged or Unable to Contact
	Incorrect or missing primary diagnosis	• Ensure you are adding the correct primary diagnosis prior to submitting your request
	Choosing incorrect provider profile in Availity	Ensure the provider profile has HNJH as one of the plans attached to the case

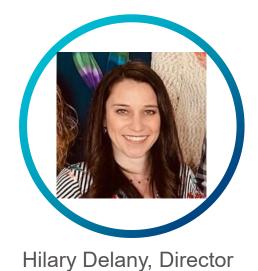

UHC Specific Processes – Tenancy/Pre-Tenancy

- Authorization Process:
 - Once the request has been received by the Housing team, it is reviewed for completion.
 - If missing information, a Housing Specialist will reach out to notify provider of needed information (i.e., member signature, etc.)
 - If complete, Housing Specialist will notify the provider via telephone of the determination.
- Notification will include the decision, dates for the authorization and if adverse determination, reason for the denial (i.e., incomplete documentation, duplicative services, does not meet Level of Need criteria)
- Submitting an appeal: See NJ Timely Filing Guidelines slide



UHC Specific Processes – Residential Modification, Remediation and Move-in Supports

- Authorization Process:
 - Once the request has been received by the Housing team it is reviewed for completion.
 - If missing information, a Housing Specialist will reach out to notify provider of needed information (i.e., member signature, etc.)
 - If complete, notify the provider via telephone of the determination.
- Notification will include the decision, dates for the authorization and if adverse determination, reason for the denial (incomplete documentation, duplicative services, does not meet Level of Need criteria)
- Residential Modification/Remediation:
 - Evaluation request forms from UHC will be faxed or emailed with instructions to fax/email it back with the requested information (i.e., cost, service provided, timeline for completion, etc.)
 - Notification via telephone if selected to provide the services
 - Upon completion of the modification, an end of services form will be faxed/emailed to the provider as well as outreach to the member to confirm completion and satisfaction
- Move-In Supports:
 - Move-in Supports providers will be faxed/emailed a standard list of itemized goods
 - Move-in Supports providers will return fax/email the list with cost and fulfillment timeline for approval
 - UHC will provide approval for purchase of goods
- Submitting an appeal: See NJ Timely Filing Guidelines slide



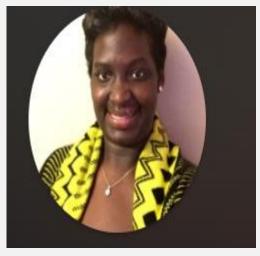

What is ICR and why should I use it?

The Interactive Care Reviewer (ICR) allows providers and facilities to submit initial and concurrent authorization requests for behavioral health (BH) services including acute inpatient stays, residential and rehabilitation stays, intensive outpatient (IOP) and partial hospitalization programs (PHP), electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) and psychiatric testing. Additionally, providers can use the inquiry feature on ICR to find information on any authorization associated with their tax id/organization.

ICR improves the efficiency of the authorization process since all authorizations are in one place and can be accessed by any staff member at any time. ICR allows users to inquire about precertification requests submitted via phone, fax, ICR or other online tools. Using ICR means you no longer must request authorizations by phone or fax since you can create the request, attach and submit clinical notes and supporting images, make updates and get responses from ICR. Another reason to use ICR is that it allows for proactive communication through email updates.

How to get access and create an account

Please Note: The person starting the registration process agrees to be the *Administrator* for your organization and will administer the addition of new users within your facility

To access ICR, you must first register via the Availity Portal - https://www.availity.com — using the following steps: Select the **REGISTER** link to be redirected to the *Registration details* landing page.

Select the appropriate organization type link and you will be directed to the Registration Form to create your account.

What is the ICR Landing Page/Dashboard?

The dashboard displays requests submitted, requests not yet submitted, cases requiring additional information and cases where a decision has been rendered. The dashboard has four tabs:

- 1. My Organization's Requests this is your home page and will display the dashboard.
- 2. **Create New Request** this is used to start a new inpatient or outpatient request.
- 3. **Search Organization Requests** allows the ability to search, using drop down menus, for any request made by your organization (through ICR, fax or phone).
- 4. **Check Case Status** allows users to view any cases submitted under your organization's tax id, including ICR, phone and fax requests.



How do I request a new authorization

To create a new authorization request select *Create New Request* from the ICR Dashboard tab, located at the top of the ICR screen. The request process consists of 5 steps and will end once you review the *Case Overview*.



Steps

- 1.Patient Details: Complete all the required fields in this section and click Find Patient. Once patient details section is completed, click Confirm Patient.
- a. Please note: When entering the request, in addition to entering the Subscriber ID, please enter at least ONE of the following Patient Identifiers: Patient First Name, Last
- 2. Service Details: Complete all required fields in this section by providing the patient's diagnosis and information about the service to be provided. (If you didn't select an authorization profile the Place of Service, Type of Service, and Level of Service will be required in addition to diagnosis.)



Steps

- 3. Provider Details: There are three provider types to choose from on ICR. The Requesting Provider, Service Provider and Ordering Physician. The Ordering Physician section only appears for certain Outpatient requests which have a Place of Service of Home or a Service such as Durable Medical Equipment or Home Health Care. (The Requesting Provider should be auto populated with the entering provider information.)
- 4.Request Summary: the page is used to verify if requested services require pre-authorization. If the service does not require pre-authorization, users can note the tracking ID and close out the request. If users need to search for the request later, it can be located using the tracking ID or patient information.
- 5.Clinical Details: Templates located in Clinical Details allow users to enter clinical detail previously provided via phone. When completing the Clinical Details section, please complete all required fields, marked with an *, on the template.
