- This is a chart that lists the Medicaid programs that are considered duplicative to each of the four Housing Supports services. Not every Medicaid program is duplicative to a Housing Supports service (e.g., MLTSS is not duplicative for Pre-tenancy services; however, it is duplicative for Move-in Supports). There are codes listed in that chart to help the provider know how that particular Medicaid program is coded in eMEVS (e.g., MLTSS can be coded as 61, 63, or 64). eMEVS stands for Electronic Medicaid Eligibility Verification System and it's how providers check if a member is enrolled in Medicaid and what Medicaid programs they are in.
